

Author of the Week



Phonics

Across school we use Little Wandle to teach phonics. This begins in Nursery where the children learn listening skills, nursery rhymes and explore stories to develop an early love of reading. In Reception, Year One and Year Two the children have daily lessons. Children in Year One will soon be taking the phonics screening check.
