## RECEPTION PLACES

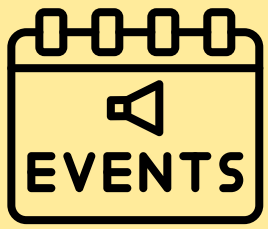

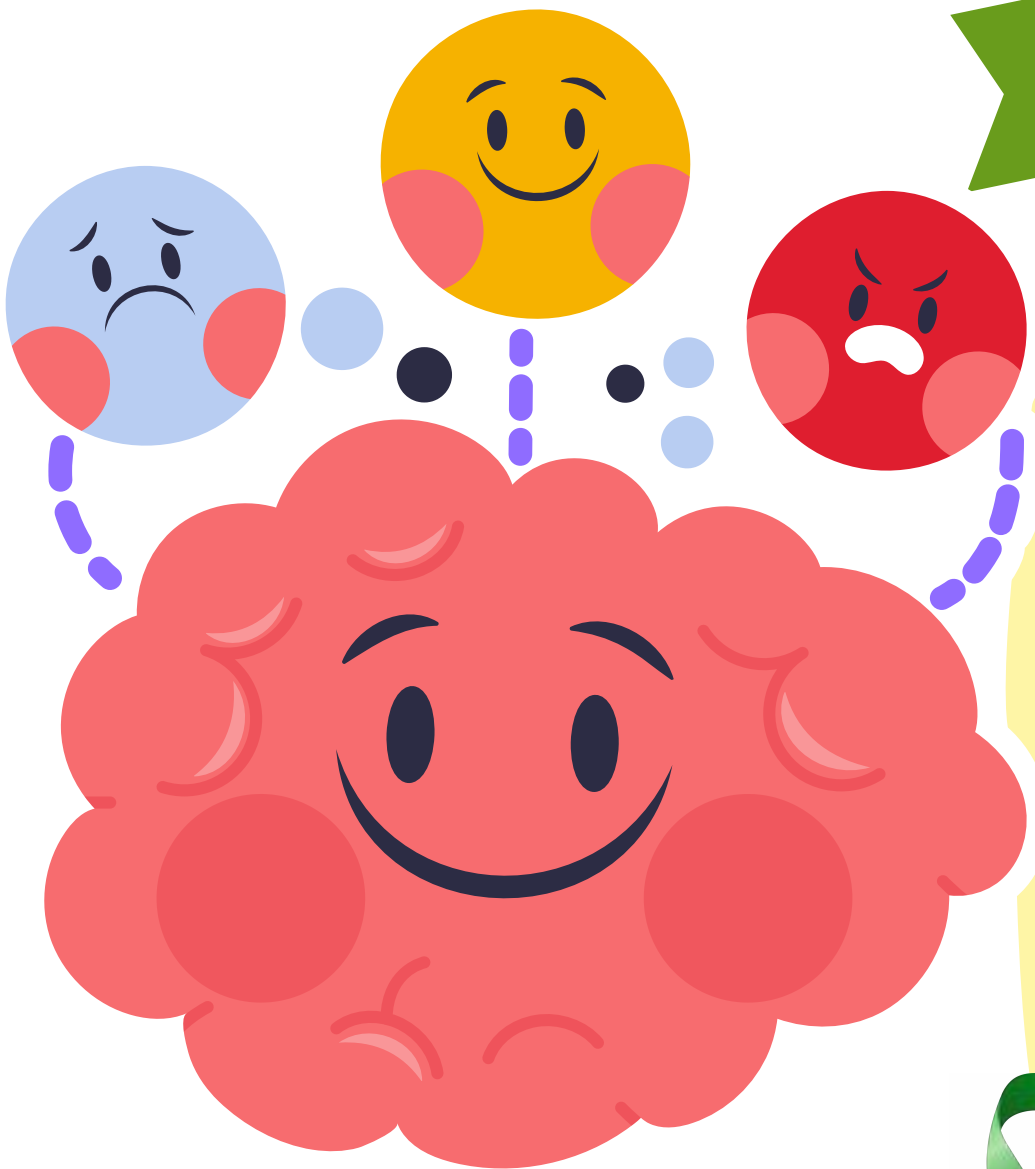
**SAVE THE DATE**
